## HOW CAN I HELP?

### I am an individual

- Challenge other businesses to meet or exceed your \$5 goal.

### I am a place of worship

- Promote this campaign through newsletters/bulletins.
- Ask members to give \$5.
- Ask members to get 5 friends to give \$5.
- Challenge another place of worship in a contest.
- Challenge age groups/classes to a contest.

### 5 reasons to give \$5

1. For every \$1 we invest in prevention, we save \$4 later on treatment related to child abuse and neglect.
2. \$5 will educate 10 new parents on the dangers of shaking a baby.
3. Over 1,300 parents, caregivers and concerned citizens called 1-800-CHILDREN last year requesting parent support or child abuse prevention information.
4. 61,754 children were reported to the Kentucky Cabinet for Health & Family Services as being the victim of abuse or neglect last year.
5. One out of three abused or neglected children will later abuse or neglect their own children, continuing the cycle of abuse.
