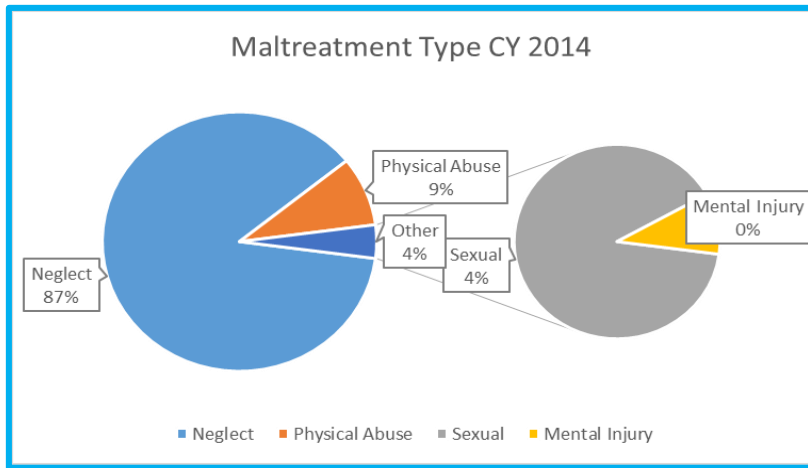


Data Facts - CY 2014

Child Protective Services (CPS) Reports to the Department for Community Based Services

- ✿ 58,114 CPS reports met criteria for investigation or assessment in 2014 with a total of 80,241 children involved in those reports.
- ✿ 22, 926 children were involved in the 14,911 reports found to be substantiated or in need of service in 2014.
- ✿ Neglect is the most common form of maltreatment, with 21,694 children involved in incidents of neglect. *



The number of children substantiated or in need of services for physical abuse was 2,151.

4,071 unique children reported for Sexual Abuse with 931 of those substantiated.

2,324 children reported for Emotional Injury with 105 of those children found to be substantiated or in need of services.

The number of CPS reports has increased each year over the past five calendar years.

From 2010 through 2014 there was a **22.9%** increase in the number of reports that met criteria for Investigation.
