To obtain CEUs you **MUST** register and sign-in at the CEU table. In order to verify your attendance, please complete a workshop evaluation for each session attended, listing your name and type of CEU or training hours desired on the bottom of each evaluation form. At the completion of each session, return the evaluation to the workshop ambassador. All CEU certificates will be emailed to participants post-conference; please allow ample time for processing prior to follow up.

To receive training credit you **must** report to the CEU Desk and fill out the proper paperwork.

Attorneys:

This conference has been approved for up to 9.25 CLE's by the Kentucky Bar Association.
